HEALTH

- During 2011-2012, we contributed to the patient airlift program.
- In 2016, we replaced all the external window frames at the Tinos Health Center with new energy efficient ones.
- In 2018, we contributed to the installation of an oxygen production plant.
- During the pandemic, we supplied the Center with equipment for COVID-19 tests.
- In 2023, we participated in the conversion of an old Municipal office into a "Doctor's House" in the village of Steni.
- We donated to the Health Center portable health equipment. We strengthened the actions of the Association of Friends of the Health Center of Tinos N. Kogos.

PAIDEIA

- We replaced the worn windows at the Primary School of Loutra, with new energy efficient ones.
- We supported school trips.
- We donated interactive whiteboards for modern teaching.

CULTURE
